Here is some of the latest news/information from Scoil Mhuire:

Uniform/Tracksuit Update

Following on from our recent survey on uniforms/tracksuits I can confirm that the Board of Management has approved moving to a tracksuit only policy i.e. the school uniform will be discontinued at the end of the school year. Furthermore, as per the feedback received regarding whether to stick with the current maroon tracksuit or explore other options, the Board sought information from several suppliers. ID Sport, based in Mitchelstown, have been identified as a possible supplier should a change be decided upon. Parents will soon get to vote on a decision to stick with the old tracksuit or move to a new lighter polyester type. I will share images of the design ID Sport have come up with prior to the vote being issued. Samples will also be available in the office for parents to actually get a feel for what they are voting on (and how they look).
